- o Teach conducting patterns and song playlist patterns
- \circ Work together and with the President to start plans for the next year
- o Teach basic communication techniques for talking to general members
- o Contribute music and ideas
- $\circ~$ Learn and speak all commands

Secretary - Andrew Lathan (Former Sec. Kari Avolis)

- o Reset the email and contact info of the general members
