

On Friday, March 27, 2009, election results were announced. It was shared that Navid Nematollahi, with 806 (50.28%) votes, was disqualified from the office of Student Body President and that Mark Blackwell, with 779 (48.60%) of the votes, was therefore the winner. Further, it was announced that Kat Pohlman, with 865 (54.37%) votes was also disqualified and that Charles Soden, with 707 (45.07%) votes was the winner for the office of Student Body Vice President. This was posted as required.

An appeal of the election results was received Saturday, March 28, 2009:

In the Spring Election Information Packet it states under "Required Votes," "Candidates and write-in candidates for Student Body President and Student Body Vice President must receive a simple majority of votes (50% +1)." This did not occur. As the decisions currently stand, Nematollahi and Pohlman are disqualified while Blackwell and Soden did not earn positions. Blackwell received 48.60% and Soden received 45.07% of the votes.

The Elections Appeals Committee convened on Monday, March 30, 2009. A motion was made to hold a run-off election since there was not a 50% + 1 majority achieved by the remaining candidates in good standing as required by the election policy. The motion carried.

Following this decision, petitions and communications were received from students expressing concern that their voices were not being heard in a democratic process.

Given the fact that the SGA Elections Packet did not outline procedures for these specific circumstances, the SGA Elections Board and Elections Appeals Committee presented recommendations to the SGA Legislature at a special session held on Thursday, April 2, 2009 at 7:30pm in the Masonboro Island Room of the Fisher Student Center. The following protocol was passed as legislation:

Polls will open for a run-off election including current on-ballot candidates in good standing (i.e. not disqualified) and write-in candidates at 12:01am Friday, April 3, 2009 and close at 3:00pm that same day. Violation forms will be due at 3:30pm on Friday, April 3, 2009 to the Campus Activities & Involvement Center. Correct and complete campaign expenditure forms are due from all candidates, both official and write-in by 12:00pm Friday, April 3, 2009. All other policies outlined in the current SGA Elections Packet stand.
